Gold to Germany with Weigelt; 10th for the italian Guichardaz in the Xco 14

The German Paulina Weigelt wore the jersey of champion of the European Youth Championship of MountainBike reserved for fourteen-year-olds, the second Xco race on the Pila track (Valle d'Aosta). Sprint for the silver medal and to win it is the Dutch Mae Cabaca, who burns the Czech Amalie Gottwaldova in a sprint.

Very fast start of the German-Dutch couple Paulina Weigelt (Ktm Youngsters Bayern) and Mae Cabaca (The Flying Lowlanders) to immediately make a void behind them; halfway through, however, it is the German - bronze in the Team relay - who increases the pace and passes the finish line of the first lap in 14'11 ", with an advantage of 42" over the Dutch and 46 "over the Czech Amalie Gottwaldova (Czech Republic 2). At 1'16 from the head of the race, a trio formed by the Austrian Antonia Grangl (Austria 1), the blue Sofia Guichardaz and the Slovenian Marusa Tereza Serkezi (Slovenija Team).

In the second and final lap Weigelt puts the victory in the freezer, further widening the gap on the pursuers. Behind her, the forcing of Gottwaldova, which recovers the gap from the Cabaca, and the two do "the elastic", up to the final two hundred meters. The greatest freshness of Mae Cabaca, at 1'17 ", with Gottwaldova having to settle for the bronze, with a delay of 1'20" from the winner. To complete the top five, Austria 1 and Austria 3, Antonia Grangl (at 1'49 ") and Magdalena Gragl (at 2'07"). The best of the Italians, 10a at 2'40 ", Sofia Guichardaz from Valle d'Aosta.

The day continues, at 2 pm, with the 13-year-old women.
